## Blackrod Art Group

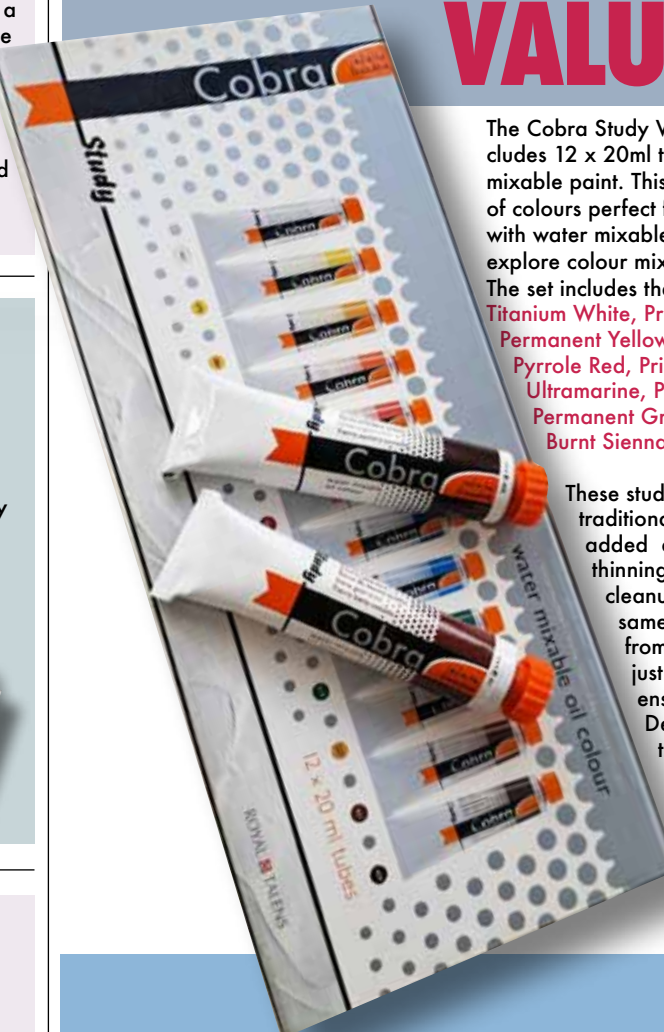
