## Well done Taysha

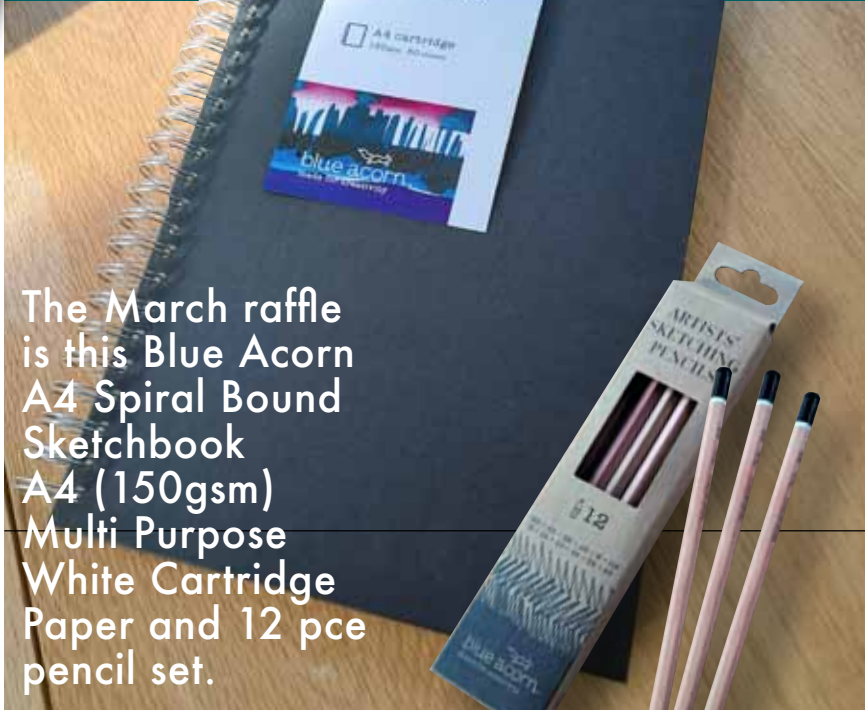
Taysha Manifold won the Garstang Open Art Competition in January with her robin pastel,

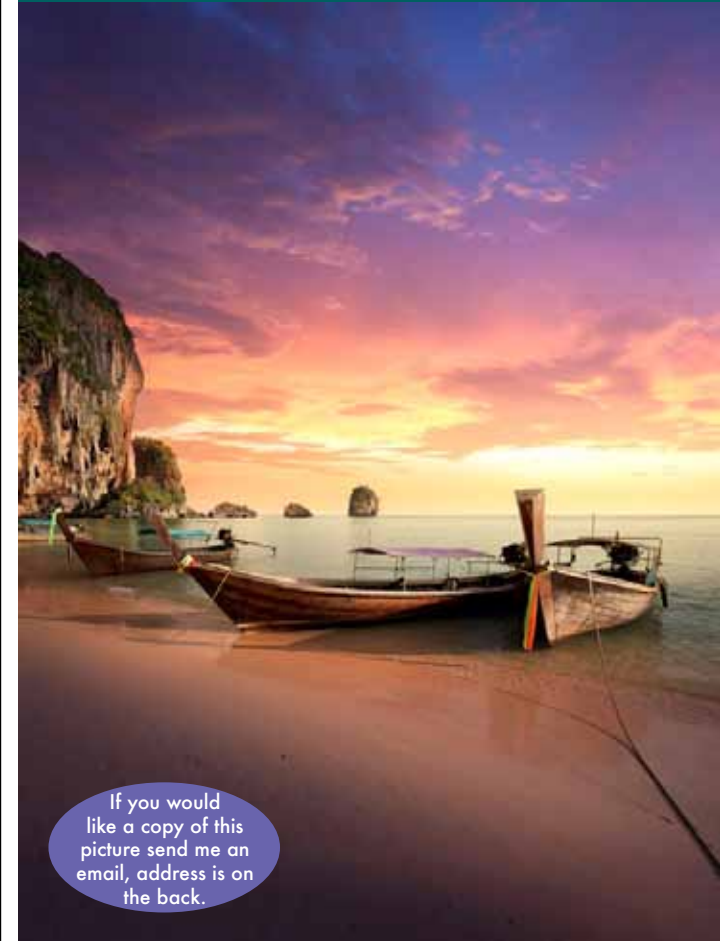
